Prenanthes crepidinea

[Synonyms : *Nabalus crepidineus*]

RATTLESNAKE ROOT is a perennial. It is native to the United States.

It is also known as Great white-lettuce, Midwestern white-lettuce, and Nodding rattlesnake root.

Crepidinea is derived from Latin *crepida* (sandal) meaning ‘sandal- or slipper-shaped’.

This tree is protected in the wild as it is considered to be rare in the states of Indiana, threatened in Kentucky and Ohio, and endangered in New York, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, and Wisconsin in the United States.
