*Prunella laciniata*

[Synonyms : *Prunella alba*, *Prunella cretensis*]

**CUT-LEAVED SELFHEAL** is a creeping perennial. Native to central and south-western Europe it has small, occasionally pink or purple, yellowish-white flowers.

It is also known as *Brunelle découpée* (French), *Černohlávek dřípatý* (Czech), *Černohlávek dřípený* (Czech), *Černohlávok zastrihovaný* (Slovak), Cutleaf selfheal, *Flikbladig brunört* (Swedish), *Flikbrunört* (Swedish), Heal all, Self heal, *Vitbrunört* (Swedish), *Weisse Brunelle* (German), and *Witte brunel* (Dutch).

*Laciniata* is derived from Latin *lacer* (torn, mangled) meaning ‘fringed or very deeply cut, torn or slashed into narrow divisions’.
