Prunus jamaskura

[Synonyms : *Prunus serrula* var. *spontanea*, *Prunus serrulata* var. *spontanea*]

HILL CHERRY is a deciduous tree. Native to Japan it has small slightly fragrant, white or pink flowers and leaves that turn red and yellow in Autumn.

It is also known as Japanese hill cherry, Japanese mountain cherry, *Shan ying hua* (Chinese),

Wild cherry, *Yama zakura* (Japanese), *Ye ying hua* (Chinese), and *Ying hua* (Chinese).

Jamaskura is a corruption of a Japanese name for this species.
