**TUFTED SALTMARSH GRASS** is a perennial grass. It is native to coastal Europe, South Africa and North America.

It is also known as Borrer's saltmarsh-grass, *Knippsaltgräs* (Swedish), and Saltmarsh alkaligrass.

It is a protected plant in the Irish Republic under the Flora Protection Order 1987.

*Fasciculata* is derived from Latin *fasciculus* (bundle, packet, fagot) meaning 'clustered or growing/grouped together in bundles'.
