Puccinellia maritima

COMMON SALTMARSH-GRASS is a perennial grass. Native to coastal western Europe it has purple or green spikelets.

It is also known as *Gewoon kweldergras* (Dutch), Goose grass, *Gweunwellt Arfor* (Welsh), *Revigt saltgräs* (Swedish), Saltmarsh grass, Sea meadow-grass, Sea poa, Seaside alkaligrass, Sea spear grass, *Strand-Annelsgæs* (Danish), and *Strandgröe* (Swedish).

Maritima is Latin (of the sea) meaning ‘coastal, or of the sea or seaside’.
