*Radiola linoides*

[Synonyms : *Millegrana radiola*, *Radiola millegrana*, *Radiola multiflora*]

**ALLSEED** is an annual. Native to Europe and the Mediterranean it has very tiny white flowers.

It is also known as Flax-seed, *Dvärglin* (Swedish), *Gorhilig* (Welsh), and *Stozrník lnovitý* (Czech).

*Linoides* is made up of the genus name *Linum* and Greek *-oides* (like) components meaning 'like plants in that (flax) genus'.

Botanists have found flowering and fruiting allseed plants of less than 0.12 in. (3 mm) in height which some surmise could be the smallest flowering land plants in the British Isles.

Medicinally, herbalists used to recommend this tiny plant for treating the onset of colds and pleurisy, and for aches and pains.
