Scrophularia vernalis

GREEN FIGWORT is a biennial or perennial. Native to Europe it has greenish-yellow flowers.

It is also known as *Frühlings-Braunwurz* (German), *Gornerth Felen* (Welsh), *Kevätsyyläjuuri* (Finnish), *Krtičník jarní* (Czech), *Krtičník jarný* (Slovak), *Vårflenört* (Swedish), and Yellow figwort.

The flowers are pollinated by bees.

Warning – like common figwort (*Scrophularia nodosa*) it is poisonous and must be used with care.

Vernalis means ‘of Spring’ (the time of year when the plant flowers).
