Stylophorum diphyllum

[Synonyms : *Chelidonium diphyllum*, *Stylophorum ohioense*]

WOOD POPPY is a perennial. Native to central and eastern North America it has small yellow flowers.

It is also known as Celandine poppy, Gold poppy, Nuttall, and Yellow poppy.

Diphyllum is derived from Greek *di-* (two, twice) and *phyllo-* (leaf) components meaning ‘two-leaved’.
