Yucca Asparagaceae [Agavaceae]

Yucca is named after cassava (Manihot esculenta) which belongs to a completely different family (Euphorbiaceae) and is sometimes called 'yuca' or 'yucca' as well.Apparently John Gerard (1545-1612) the English barber-surgeon and herbalist, is said to have been confused by that plant and to have thought that cassava was a member of this subsequently named Yucca genus.
